to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the Service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1955.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly as follows:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. I) Act, 1955.

Rs. 3,02,75, State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of of Assam for three crores, two lakhs, seventy-five thousand, two the year hundred and seven rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1955 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1955.
