Ne.LGL.41/84/18.—The following Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

ASSAM ACT NO. VI OF 1984

(Received the assent of the Governor on 29th March, 1984) THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. II) ACT, 1984

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year 1984-85.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly in the Thirty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropria-Short title. tion (No. II) Act, 1984.

Withdrawal of financial year 1984-85.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Rs. 1420,78,63,000 State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums from and out of not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Consolidated not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Fund of the State Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one of Assam for the thousand tour hundred twenty crores seventy-eight lakhs and sixty three thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1984-85 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the Thirty first day of March, 1985.
