THE MOTOR VEHICLES (ASSAM
AMENDMENT) ACT, 1983

Act

further to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, ^{General Act} IV of 1939-
1939 in its application to Assam.

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, in its application to Assam, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Thirty-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title,
extent and
commence-
ment.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Motor Vehicles (Assam Amendment) Act, 1983.

(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Assam.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Insertion of
new Section
43A in Gen-
eral Act, IV
of 1939.

2. In the principal Act, after Section 43, the following shall be inserted as Section 43A, namely:—

“Special
power of the
State Govern-
ment to issue
orders and
give direc-
tions.

43A. (1) The State Government may issue orders and directions of general character, not in consistant with the provision of the Act, as it may consider necessary, in respect of any matter relating to Road Transport to the State

Transport Authority, or to a Regional Transport Authority or the Regional Transport Authorities and such transport authorities shall give effect to all such orders and directions.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of sub-section (1) above, the State Government in particular may direct the State Transport Authority or any Regional Transport Authority to open new route or to extend any existing route or to permit additional stage or contract carriages to be put or increase or reduce the number of such carriages on any specified route or area."
