No.LGL.28/83.—The following Act of the Assam Legislative Assembly which received the assent of the Governor is hereby published for general information.

ASSAM ACT NO. I OF 1983

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 27th March 1983)

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. 1) ACT, 1983

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of the financial year 1982-83.

Be it enacted by Assam Legislative Assembly in the Thirtyfourth Year of the Republic of India as follows: -

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. I) Act, 1983.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Withdrawal of 2. From and out of the Consumation of the Rs. 186,21,82,500 State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums of the from and out of the Consolidated not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Fund of the State schedule amounting in the aggregate [inclusive of of Assam for the sums specified in column 3 of the Schedule to the order made by the President on the 7th February, 1983 under sub-clause (c) of clause (1) of article 357 of the Constitution and published with the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance No. SO. 94 (E) dated the 7th February, 1983] to the sum of one hundred and eighty-six crores, twenty-one lakhs, eighty-two thousand and five hundred rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1982-83 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
