1954

12th August 1954)**[Published in the *Assam Gazette*, dated the 18th August 1954]*An**Act*

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1955.

Be it enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (No. III) Act, 1954.

Issue of

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of seventy-four lakhs, fifty-seven thousand five hundred and thirty-three rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1955, in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 1955.

to amend the Assam Local Self-Government Act, 1953

Preamble.—Whereas it is expedient to amend the Assam Local Self-Government Act, 1953 (Assam Act XXV of 1953), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, in the manner hereinafter appearing :

It is hereby enacted in the fifth year of our Republic as follows :—

1. **Short title, extent and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Assam Local Self-Government (Amendment) Act, 1954.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.
2. **Amendment of section 1.**—In section 1 of the principal Act—
 - (a) In sub-section (2) the words “or the Assam Rural Panchayat Act, 1948” shall be deleted.
