#### PARLIAMENT ACT NO. 11 OF 1982

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (VOTE-ON-ACCOUNT) ACT, 1982

> An Act

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam for the services of a part of the financial year 1982-83.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Thirty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 1982.

Withdrawal of Rs. 479,65,38,000 State of Assam there may be withdrawn sums not the Consolidated exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule Fund of the State amounting in the aggregate to the sum of four hundred of Assam for the and seventy-nine crores, sixty-five lakhs and thirty-eight financial 1982-83. which will come in course of payment during the financial year 1982-83

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year,
