(Received the assent of the Governor on the 31st March, 1981).

THE ASSAM APPROPRIATION (NO. I) ACT, 1981

ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam to the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 1981.

It is hereby enacted in the thirty-second year of the Republic of India as follows :-

1. This Act may be called the Assam Appro-Short title priation (No. I) Act, 1981

Withdrawal of Rs, 8,86,67,117 from and out of the Consoli-dated Fund of State of Assam to the services of the Financial year 1980-81.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Rupees eight crores eightyseven lakhs seventeen thousand one hundred and seventeen towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March. 1981 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Assam by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the a mois monthrity-first day of Marchai 1981 2522/ synulciped
